


# Letter to Mr. and Mrs. Miller

baseball through your window while you were out. \_\_\_\_\_ 24




We didn't mean to do it. Jake \_\_\_\_\_ 31

find it again. \_\_\_\_\_ 90


You're the best people in our neighborhood. We'd \_\_\_\_\_ 98




## Recycle and Make Less Trash




## Frog Classroom Rules
